This is our sanctuary.



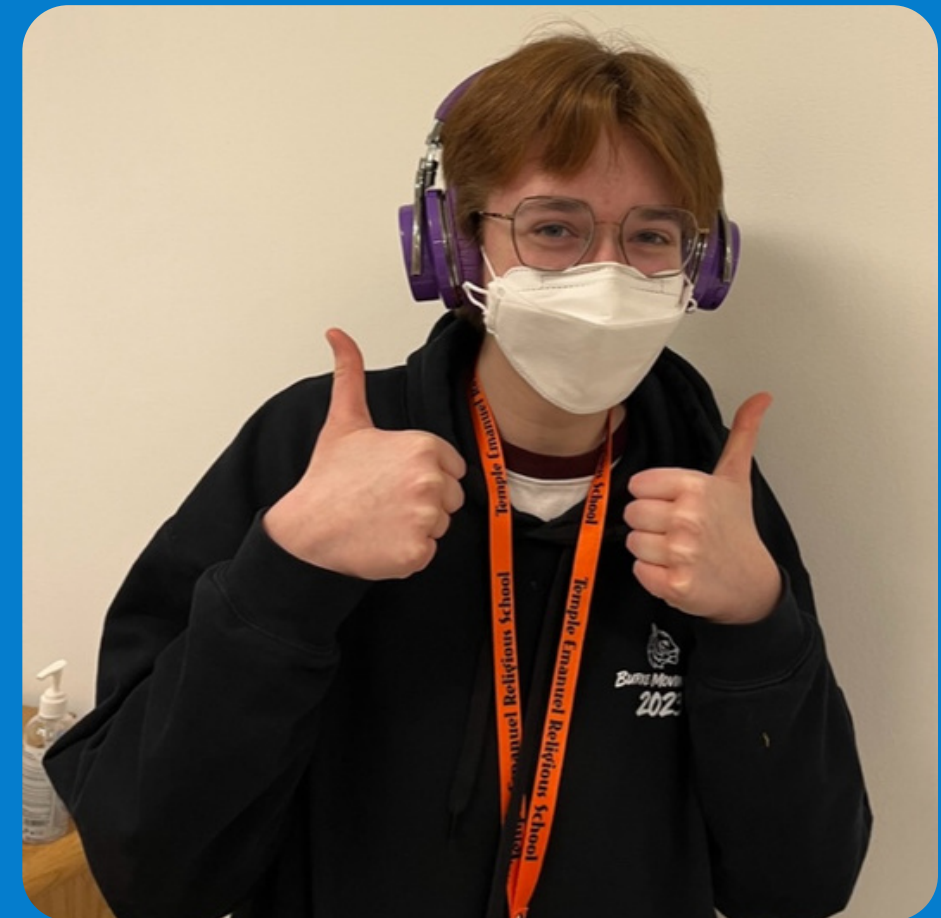
We have prayer books.
