

# Going to Shabbat Services at Temple Emanuel



### This is our sanctuary.




We have prayer books. I will be careful and treat this book with respect.

> **Temple Emanuel** honors each person's gender identity and choice of which restroom is best for their personal use


There is a basket of books and fidgets in the front of the sanctuary if I need a break.
