respect.



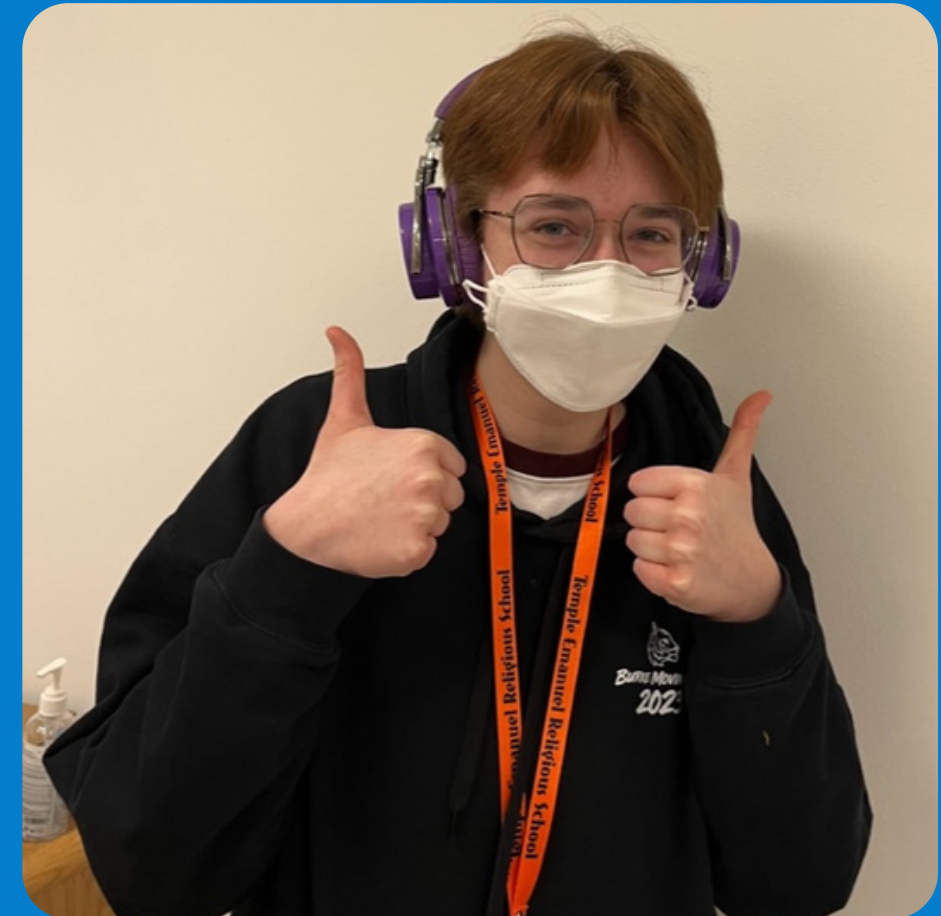
There will be bagels I can buy, but I will need to eat my breakfast in the lobby before I go into the sanctuary.

movement break.





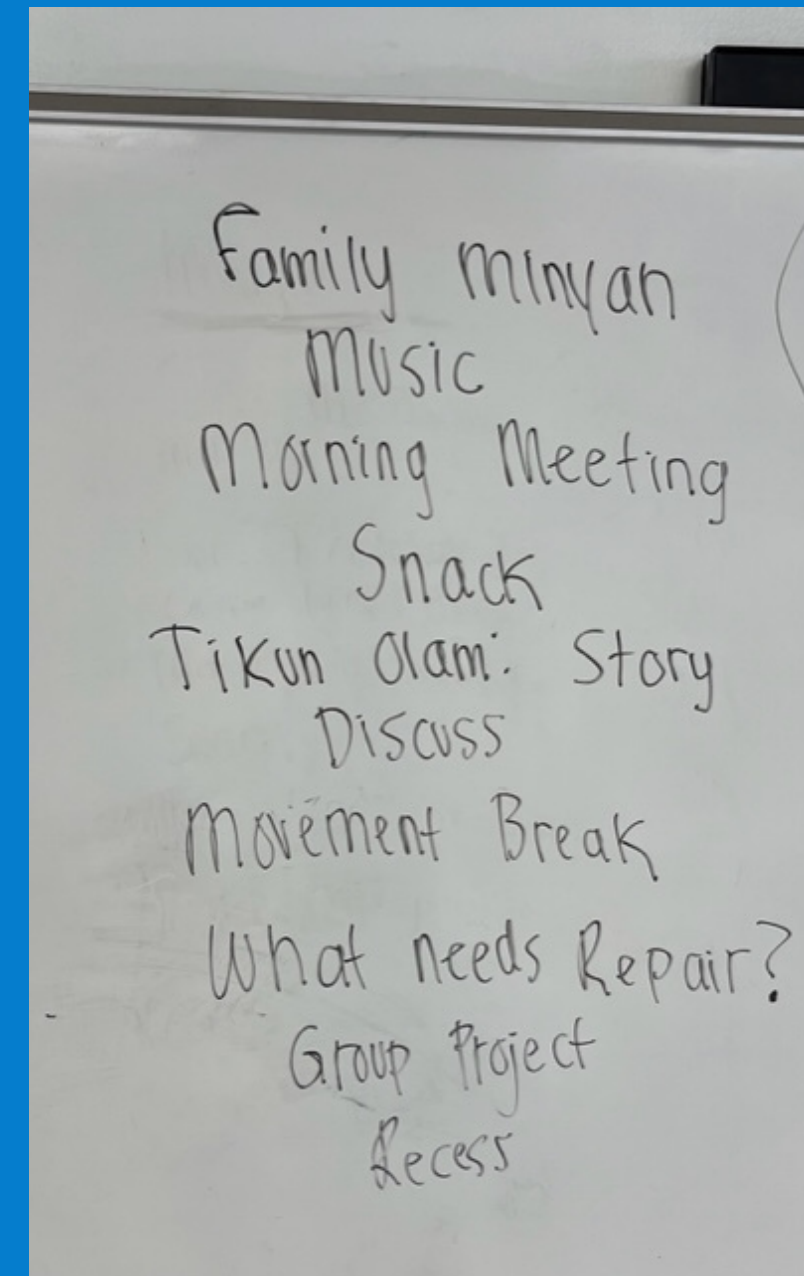
I can take a break in

When minyan is over, we will walk to class with our teachers, madrichol, and classmates. Our family will leave and come back to pick us up later.



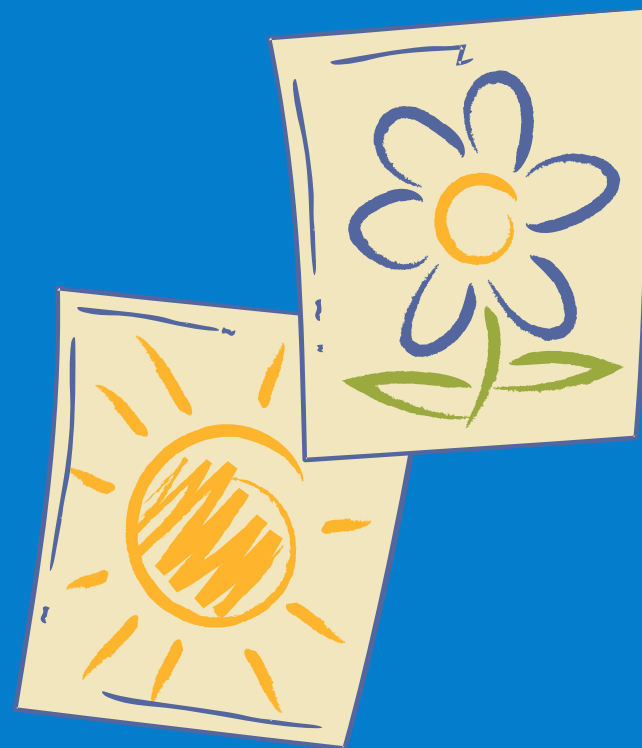
There will be a

classroom.



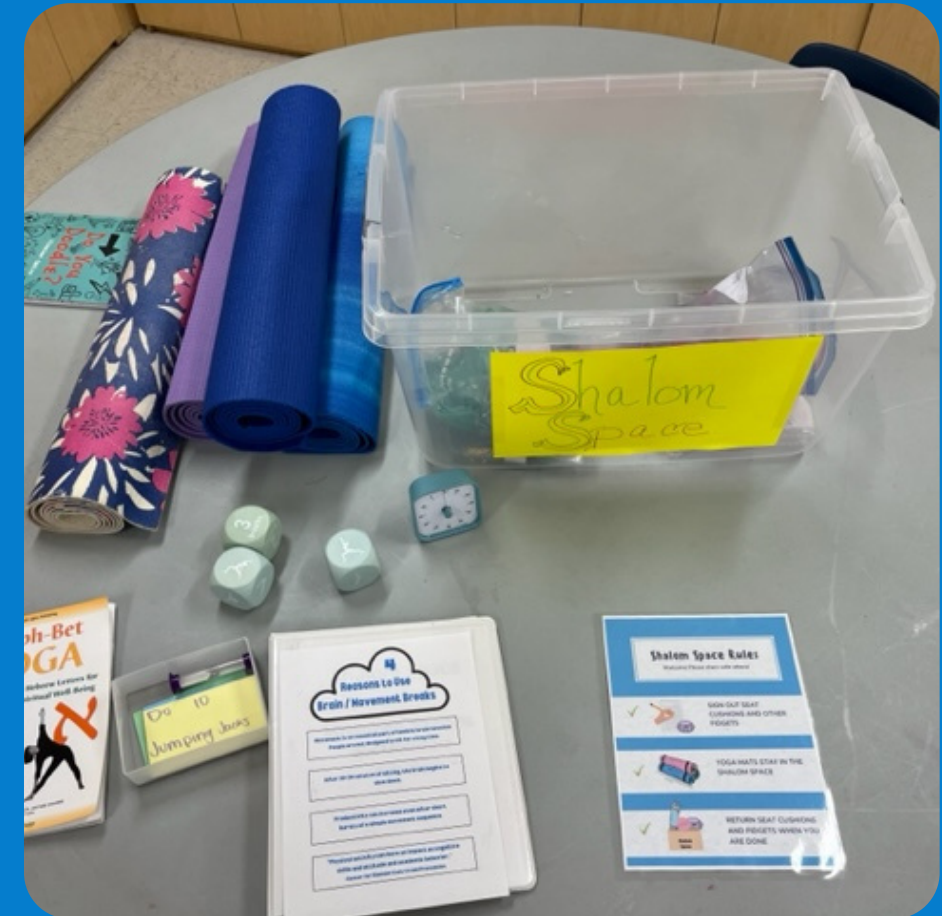
We will practice Hebrew and learn about Jewish holidays.

art and music.



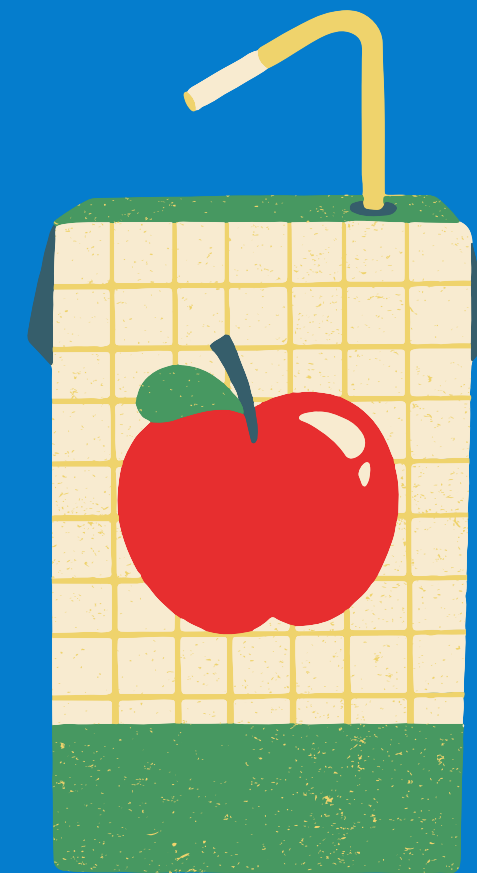
I can ask my teachers and madrichol to go to the Shalom Space if I need a movement break, seat cushion, or fidget.



I can ask my teachers and madrichol for a fidget or seat cushion to use in class.

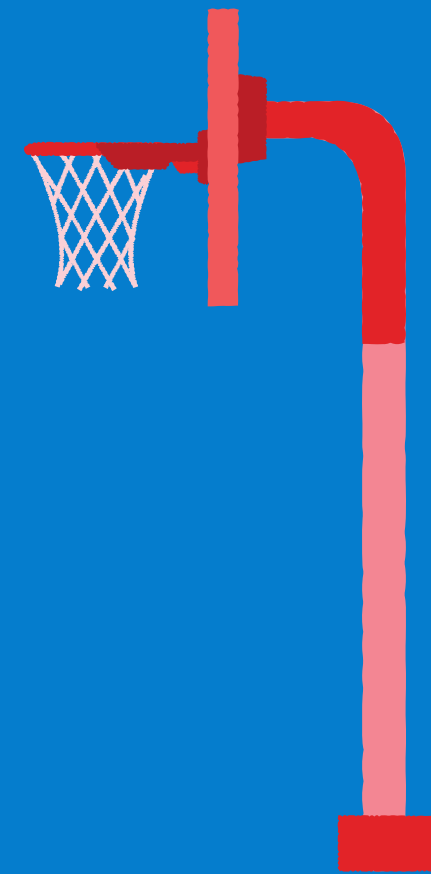
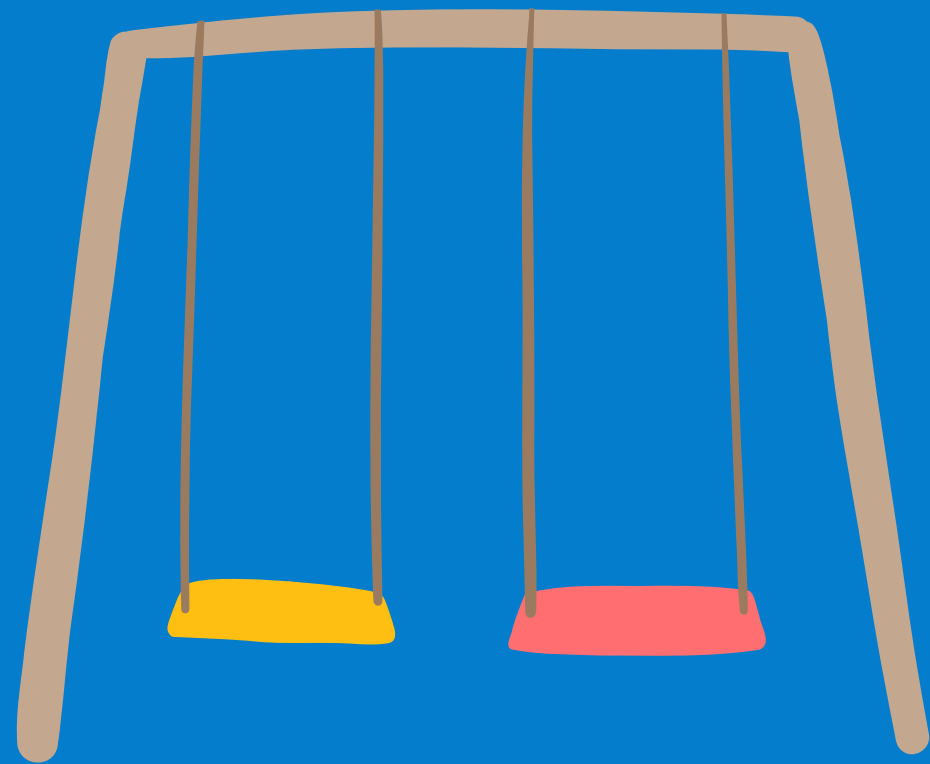


We will say a prayer (motzi), eat challah, and drink juice during our break time.
